Security Update for the OPC UA .NET Standard Stack

Executive Summary

This security update resolves a vulnerability in OPC UA Servers built with the OPC UA .NET Standard stack that could allow a malicious actor to trigger a stack overflow.

Vendors that incorporate the OPC UA .NET stack into their products must update their products.

This security update has a base score of 7.5 (high) using the CVSS v3.1 guidelines.

The CVSS vector string is:

CVSS:3.1/AV:N/AC:L/PR:N/UI:N/S:U/C:N/I:N/A:H
